Rules and Prerequisites for Buckeye District #11 Ahepan of the Year

An AHEPAN of the YEAR shall be selected and announced at the AHEPA Buckeye District Convention. The qualifications and submission procedure listed below shall be followed in order to qualify.

Eligibility:

Any member of the AHEPA in good standing with his chapter, and whose chapter is in good standing with National Headquarters, is eligible.

Chapter level:

Each application shall be prepared on the official entry form by the chapter's nominating committee, in triplicate (one copy for the Chapter files, one copy for the District Governor, and one copy for the District Secretary). If needed the application may be accompanied by additional typewritten pages, describing the accomplishments of the applicant. No other material will be considered.

The entry form must be forwarded to the District Governor and District Secretary, signed by the Chapter Secretary and President, by June 1st of the convention year.

District level:

The District Governor shall appoint an AHEPAN of the Year Committee Chairman from the Past District Governors, preferably a Brother who is familiar with the procedures to judge and select the winner.

The appointed chairman shall review the applications for errors. If the application is incorrectly filled, the chapter will be notified and given the opportunity to make a correction. If the correction is not completed at least one week prior to the convention, the application will be disqualified.

As his last obligation, the outgoing District Governor shall submit with the assistance of the winner's chapter, the National Ahepan of the Year Application Form, with photo. A letter verifying the District selection shall accompany the application to National Headquarters.
