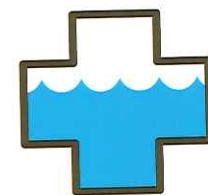

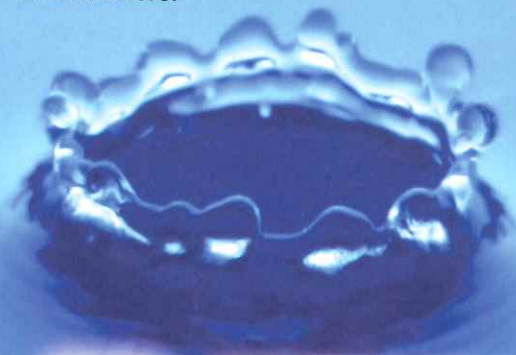
## A Simple (and Smart) Plan
