# **DISTRICT LODGE FUNDRAISER UPDATE**

The "Workless Fundraiser" is here and ends May 1<sup>st</sup>. By now you should have received from your Chapter President and/or Secretary the letter from DLG Debbie Urse explaining how Chapters and individuals can support this important fundraiser. Some background information: Chapter payment of District Obligations, which were due December 2016, are vital, and the Lodge thanks every Chapter who met that responsibility. Unfortunately, these Chapter payments still do not cover the expenses of the District budget approved at Convention, so additional fundraising is necessary to not only meet the District's own operating expenses, but to also meet the philanthropic targets for the District.

How will we do all of this? Simply put, we are asking for monetary donations in any amount. Generosity is encouraged and will be rewarded at the District Convention for both the greatest Chapter, and individual, support for the "Workless Fundraiser." It's workless because we are asking each of you to take the money that you would have spent on gas, tolls, meals, hotels, raffles, etc. to attend a signature fundraiser (e.g., Festival of Tables, Purse Bingo), and instead send in a check. We're saving the host chapter and Lodge from the work of putting on the fundraiser and risking those expenses; we're saving the donors from the work of attending a fundraiser in the reality of unpredictable weather and health issues; and we're able to focus the donations to go towards the District needs rather than to fund the fundraiser itself. It's a win-win for everyone, and the Lodge sincerely hopes everyone will support it in some way.

<u>BUCKEYE SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION</u> -All obligations/donations paid to the District by May 1<sup>st</sup> for the Foundation, a permanent project, goes to the new Daughters of Penelope Buckeye D-11 Scholarship, which will help our youth access higher education. Thank you for growing the fund.

MAIDS OF ATHENA -Similarly, all obligations/donations paid to the District by May 1<sup>st</sup> for the MOA, a permanent project, goes to the MOA D-11 Lodge to support their great work. Did you know that for years D-11 had the only MOA Lodge until D-23 in Canada recently formed one? ## **HOW TO GET READY FOR THE DISTRICT CONVENTION**

Mark your calendars for the 89<sup>th</sup> Buckeye District #11 Convention hosted by Polydama #111 and AHEPA #113 from June 2-3, 2017 at the Holiday Inn, Fairborn (Dayton), OH. Registration, hotel, golf outing, and ad book details were mailed to each Chapter and are on the District Website.

HOLD CHAPTER'S APRIL MEETING: NOTE THE NEW DISTRICT FORMS DEADLINE IS MAY 1st (NOT MAY 15<sup>th</sup>) DUE TO NEW DISTRICT CONVENTION DATE. Therefore, be prepared in April to:

- Elect officers for 2017-2018 and submit Chapter Election Results by May 1, 2017\*
- Elect delegates and alternates to District Convention and submit report to Credentials Committee by May 1, 2017 (and submit registrations by May 5, 2017)
- Select a Daughter of Penelope nominee (if any) and submit her application by May 1, 2017
- Select a Penelope of the Year nominee (if any) and submit her application by May 1, 2017\*
- Submit District "Workless Fundraiser" donation(s) by May 1, 2017
- Complete In Memory of Forms and submit by May 1, 2017\*
- Complete the Year End Report and submit by May 1, 2017
- Immediately pay all District Obligations to be in good standing and seated at Convention
- Vote to place ad and submit by May 5, 2017 to District Convention host

<u>CONTINUE TO RECRUIT AND REINSTATE</u>: It's never too late because membership runs a calendar year. Once again for the second straight year D-11 ended 2016 as the largest in the worldwide DOP realm with 541 members. Keep up the great work sisters recruiting, retaining and re-instating members. In fact, the final Growth & Expansion contest continues until May 30<sup>th</sup>: for every 2 new members added to a Chapter by then, one entry goes into a drawing for a \$250 gift card. The Award will be presented at 2017 Supreme Convention in Orlando, FL.

<u>THE LODGE</u>: Considering running for the Lodge? Please do! Qualifications are stated in Art XVII, §4 of the DOP Constitution. Feel free to contact the District Governor or your Lodge Liaison with any questions or ask about submitting your letter of interest.
